

## Kyle F. Jette

Mr. Kyle Jette is a retired Army Colonel with over 26 years of active duty service, serving almost half of that time at the Pentagon under Headquarters, Department of the Army as well as the Office of the Secretary of Defense. Prior to coming to DAU, Mr. Jette worked as a contractor supporting the Army G-3, Training & Readiness domain Data Steward on the Data Steward Management Team. Previous civilian service includes serving as the Chief Data Officer (and Acting Chief Information Officer) at the Army's Program Executive Office – Enterprise Information Systems, and as Lead Data Scientist at the Army's Vantage Data Analytics Platform.

As a former Army Operations Research Officer, Kyle served in positions of increasing responsibility within the highest levels of the Department of the Army and Department of Defense, including: Division Chief of the Acquisition Support Program Analysis Division, Army Program Analysis and Evaluation Directorate; Manpower Analyst and Program Review Lead, Economic and Manpower Analysis Division, Office of the Secretary of Defense, Cost Analysis and Program Evaluation; and, Liaison Officer from the Army G-8 to the Coalition Forces Land Component Command at Camp Arifjan, Kuwait during Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom.

Mr. Jette has significant teaching experience, including serving as an Assistant Professor for three years in the Department of Social Sciences at the United States Military Academy, which included performing as the course director for the core course in American Politics. He also served as an Assistant Professor of Economics at the Eisenhower School for National Security and Resource Strategy.

Kyle has earned a Bachelor's degree in Applied Economics from the United States Military Academy, and Master's Degrees from the University of Missouri – Rolla (Engineering Management), the John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University (Public Administration), and the National Defense University, Eisenhower School for National Security and Resource Strategy (Master of National Security and Resource Strategy – Distinguished Graduate).

Mr. Jette's awards and recognitions include the Legion of Merit (2<sup>nd</sup> Award), Army Data Driven Leadership Certificate Program, Carnegie Mellon University (2021), and the 2019 DoD CIO Annual Award for Cyber and IT Excellence (Winner - Individual Category).
